


Taking the GED test



The GED test is given monthly at Boonville High School. The cost for the test is \$70.00 and is open to anyone 18 years of age or older. Registration for the GED can be done at the Warrick County School Corporation office located at 300 E. Gum Street in Boonville or by calling 897-6037. Registration is limited to fifteen (15) people each month. Those interested persons who are 17 must first pass the GED pre-test before being eligible to take the GED test.
