



FROM THE INDIANA STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLING IN
KINDERGARTEN FOR THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR

5 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis (DTaP), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTP), (4 doses are acceptable if the 4th dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the 3rd dose).

4 doses of polio (poliomyelitis) The 4th dose must be administered on or after the 4th birthday. (3 doses of all OPV or IPV are acceptable if the 3rd dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday)

2 doses of MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) on or after the first birthday.
The 2nd dose of MMR must be given at least **28 days** after the 1st dose

3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine (3rd dose must be given on or after 24 weeks of age and no earlier than 16 weeks after the 1st dose).

2 doses of the Varicella, (chickenpox) vaccine, on or after the child's 1st birthday (and separated by at least 3 months between doses) or PHYSICIAN WRITTEN DOCUMENTATION OF THE MONTH AND YEAR THAT YOUR CHILD HAD THE DISEASE.

It is very important that parents make an appointment **NOW** to get these required immunizations. **A record of these immunizations must be on file in the nurse's office, ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL, in order for your child to be able to attend school or we must have a written medical exemption from your physician or a religious exemption from you on file. Your physician may fax the records to the school nurse at 812**

A physical examination is recommended but not required.

Please Note: If you have private health insurance that covers immunizations, you will need to contact your primary care physician to get the immunizations. If you **DO NOT** have insurance, you may contact the Warrick County Health Department at 812-897-6105 for information about getting the immunizations.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS IN GRADE 1
FOR THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR

5 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis (DTaP), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTP), (4 doses are acceptable if the 4th dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the 3rd dose).

4 doses of polio (poliomyelitis) The 4th dose must be administered on or after the 4th birthday. (3 doses of all OPV or IPV are acceptable if the 3rd dose is administered on or after the 4th birthday)

3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine (3rd dose must be on or after 24 weeks of age)

2 doses of MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) on or after the 1st birthday (with the 2nd dose being given with at least a 28 day interval after the 1st dose)

2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine on or after the 1st birthday (and separated by at least 3 months between doses) or PHYSICIAN WRITTEN DOCUMENTATION OF THE MONTH AND YEAR THAT YOUR CHILD HAD THE DISEASE.

*******It is very important that you make an appointment NOW if your child is lacking any of these immunizations. A record of the immunizations must be on file in the nurse's office ON THE FIRST DAY of school in order for your child to be able to attend (or we must have a written medical exemption from your physician or a religious exemption from you on file.) Please send verification of these immunizations to the school nurse office or have your doctor fax your child's immunization record to the school nurse at 812-_____.**

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 2
THRU 5 FOR THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR

5 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis (DTaP), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTP), (4 doses are acceptable if the 4th dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the 3rd dose).

4 doses of polio (poliomyelitis) The 4th dose must be administered on or after the 4th birthday. (3 doses of all OPV or IPV are acceptable if the 3rd dose is administered on or after the 4th birthday)

3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine

2 doses of MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) on or after the 1st birthday (with the 2nd dose being given at least 28 days after the 1st dose)

1 dose of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine on or after the 1st birthday or A SIGNED STATEMENT FROM THE PARENT/GUARDIAN INDICATING HISTORY OF YOUR CHILD HAVING THE CHICKEN POX DISEASE, INCLUDING THE MONTH AND YEAR OF THE DISEASE

A record of the immunizations must be on file in the nurse's office ON THE FIRST DAY of school in order for your child to be able to attend (or we must have a written medical exemption from your physician or a religious exemption from you on file.)
