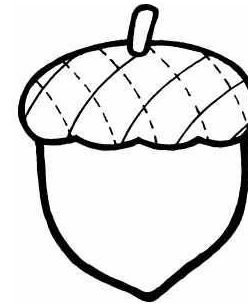

The MAP fluency program tests students in early reading skills such as Letter Naming, Rhyming, First Sound Fluency, Phoneme Segmentation Fluency, Nonsense Word Fluency, and Oral Reading Fluency. In addition students' comprehension levels are assessed using this tool and NWEA. NWEA assesses students on reading and math adapting to their skills. Based on these benchmark assessments, all students are placed into a flexible group where they receive instruction based upon their individual needs.

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Third, Fourth, and Fifth Grade Services

- **Remediation based on NWEA performance assessment in Language Art and Math**
- **Response to Intervention**



Students needing additional reinforcement will work with Title I staff in small groups while the remaining students also study the standards at their proficiency level (below, on, or above). All students receive necessary instruction at their level of proficiency.
