Mission: The Credit Recovery Program (CRP) is designed to enable upper class high school students who are in good standing at their high schools the opportunity to recover credits that they have lost. The program is especially aimed at meeting the needs of seniors who are in danger of not graduating on schedule.

Curriculum: The Credit Recovery Program will utilize the Nova Net computer-based program to deliver the instructional materials. An instructor will be on site to guide students through the Nova Net program. The time necessary to complete an individual class will vary depending on each student's academic strengths and personal commitment.

Referral: A candidate for the CRP can only be referred by the high school counselor. Due to limited space, first priority will be given to seniors, then juniors, etc....Due to the significant amount of reading involved in the curriculum, a 9th grade reading proficiency is strongly recommended in order for the student to be successful.

Admission: The student and parent will meet with the high school counselor to enroll in CRP. An agreement outlining the guidelines of the program must be signed at that time. The time for a student's start date in CRP will be based on availability of space. The administrator at the Warrick Education Center will notify the student when to start.

Fee: This is a fee-based program. There is a non-refundable \$75.00 fee for each course in which the student enrolls. **All fees must be paid prior to the start of the class.** Requests for special consideration regarding fees should be directed to the high school counselor.

Grades: All semester grades will be determined using the grading scale suggested by the Warrick County School Corporation:

- A.....95-100
- B.....88-94
- C.....77-87
- D.....70-76
- F.....0-69

End of Course Assessments: All ECA's will be administered by the student's home high school.

Schedule:

Session 1...Monday/Wednesday

Session 2...Tuesday/Thursday

Friday will be an open session for students who wish to attend.

Time: 3:30 pm - 6:30 pm

Attendance: Students will be allotted two (2) unexcused absences. Absences beyond this allotment may result in the student forfeiting enrollment in CRP.

All classes must be completed prior to the end of the current school semester in order to be credited toward the current school year's graduation.

The Credit Recovery Program is held at the Warrick Education Center, located across Hwy 261 from Castle High School.
